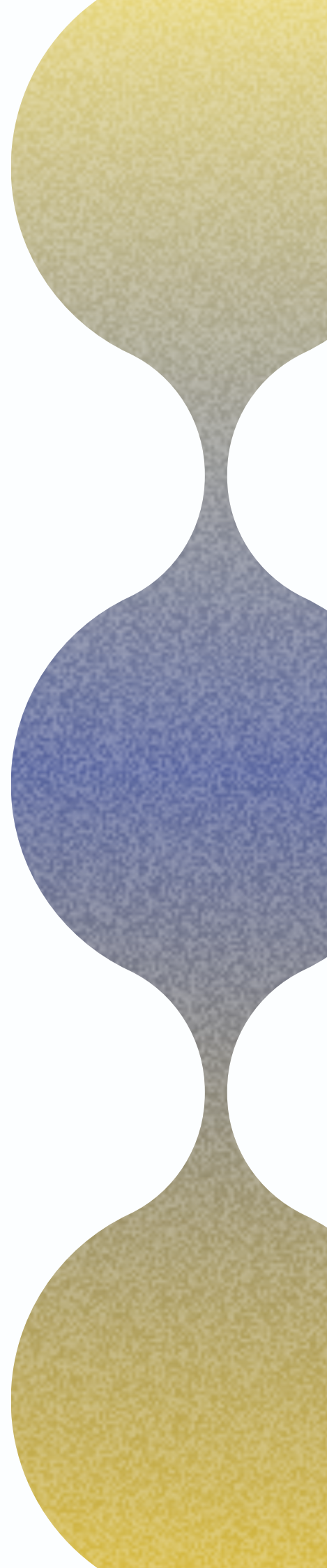

## **ABOUT THE WORKSHOP**

*The purpose of this Paper Development Workshop (PDW) is to support Brazilian and broader Latin American scholars in transforming early-stage ideas into rigorous research projects and publishable manuscripts aligned with the Business Ethics scholarship. The PDW will provide structured guidance and constructive feedback from experienced scholars serving as JBE editors and senior business ethics researchers.*

***The Workshop will grant R\$ 1.100,00 (eleven hundred Brazilian Reais) for each of its 16 participants.***

## **WHY JOIN IT?**

*Brazil and Latin America remain underrepresented in the Journal of Business Ethics community as authors and reviewers. This workshop aims to strengthen writing and publishing capabilities, foster regional networks, and encourage high-quality submissions from the region and the broader Global South.*

## **APPLICATION GUIDELINES**

*Workshop participant selection will be competitive since there are only 16 available slots. Academics at the early and mid-career stages are welcome to apply to the workshop. Advanced doctoral students (in the dissertation writing stage), doctoral fellows, and junior faculty from Brazil of Latin American origin, or based in Latin America or the Global South, are particularly encouraged to apply. The selection of applications for the workshop will be based on the completeness and quality of their application.*

*Applicants must send:*

*A SHORT COVER LETTER (max. 2 pages) outlining why you want to attend the workshop and your research interests.*

*A CURRICULUM VITAE*

*A MANUSCRIPT in English you have already prepared or an EXTENDED ABSTRACT of a manuscript in English that will be completed for submission by early-September 2026.*
