

CALL FOR THEME PROPOSALS FOR THE TRIENNIUM 2025-2027

The Brazilian Academy of Management – ANPAD announces a public call for theme proposals for its scientific conferences to be held during the triennium 2025-2027. All those interested in contributing to promote teaching, research, and knowledge production within the field of administration, accounting, and related sciences may submit proposals.

This public call aims to expand the themes of ANPAD's Divisions and Interest Groups and better reflect the distribution of research groups in the area. The intention is to offer themes that favor submissions from international participants, strengthening research networks.

General information

- 1. This call refers to all scientific conferences of ANPAD to be held in the triennium 2025-2027.
- 2. Proposals must be submitted in Portuguese and English.
- Proposals must be submitted exclusively through the ANPAD website (www.anpad.org.br).
- 4. The coordination of each Division and Interest Group will approve the number of themes it deems necessary to address the different theoretical and methodological approaches, in agreement with ANPAD's scientific director.
- 5. The coordination of each Division and Interest Group may propose themes and appoint theme leaders to complete the submissions received from the academic community, ensuring that the different theoretical and methodological approaches are covered.
- 6. Themes may be included, excluded, or modified during the triennium at the discretion of the coordination and committee of each Division and Interest Group, in agreement with ANPAD's scientific director.
- 7. The Divisions will be responsible for promoting this call for theme proposals, encouraging active community participation.

Proponents

- 8. This public call will accept theme (or tracks) proposals submitted by teams of at least two. In order to ensure the development of new leaders and/or the greater internationalization of EnANPAD, teams may have up to three researchers. In this case, it is recommended that the third be a new research leader or a researcher from an international or foreign institution, according to the following criteria:
 - a) All team members must have an iANPAD registration;
 - b) At least one of the proposers must be linked to a Program associated as an ANPAD Full Member. The other proposers, if they are not linked to a Program associated with ANPAD, must have active individual membership;



- c) Preferably, members of the proposing team should have defended their PhD dissertation at least five years ago;
- d) Members of proposing teams must be linked to different Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and preferably from various states in their country/countries;
- e) Each team member can participate in only one theme proposal, regardless of whether inside or outside their main Division and Interest Group:
- 9. ANPAD's board of directors, coordinators' and scientific committees' members of ANPAD's Divisions and Interest Groups cannot participate in this call for theme proposals.

Schedule

10. The process schedule is as follows:

Activities of proposing teams

- 11. Upon submitting the proposal, the teams committ to engage in all activities inherent to coordinating the ANPAD's Interest Groups, as follows:
 - a) Disseminate and actively promote the theme in research groups in Brazil and abroad, seeking to obtain quality submissions;
 - b) Collaborate with the Division's coordinators in matters related to ANPAD's conferences for the year in which the theme is presented;
 - c) Manage the review process of submitted scientific papers;
 - d) Identify a sufficient number of competent and engaged reviewers from the initial list of reviewers proposed;
 - e) Request that reviewers adequately fill in their data on themes of interest;
 - f) Allocate the papers received among the reviewers according to their area of expertise, topic, and work capacity;
 - g) Provide the necessary information to reviewers so they can prepare their reports in a complete and constructive manner;
 - h) Organize the approved papers in sessions and designate coordinators and/or debaters for each session;
- 11.1 It is expected of a theme leader to be present at ANPAD's conferences and the theme sessions, participating in the discussion, and promoting the Division and Interest Groups among the participants of the event;



Selection of proposals

- 12. The selection of theme proposals will be carried out by the Divisions' coordinators together with the Scientific Committee, based on the pre-established criteria outlined herein.
 - a) Conflicts or issues regarding the theme proposals must be taken to the scientific director for analysis and a final opinion;
- 13. Theme proposals will be selected considering the following criteria:
 - a) Alignment of the proposing teams to the proposed theme;
 - b) The experience of the team members on the theme;
 - c) Previous experience of the proposing team members in academic conferences (as reviewers, theme leaders, among others); journals (editor, reviewer, editorial board member); or equivalent activity, in Brazil and/or abroad;
 - d) Adequacy of the theme to the Division, considering the theoretical breadth and plurality;
 - e) Participation of the team members in graduate programs registered as ANPAD's full member associate (Membro efetivo);
 - f) Participation of the team members as researchers affiliated with international institutions.
- 14. The Division and Interest Groups' coordinators, the Scientific Committee, and the ANPAD's Board of Directors may suggest changes in the themes, adjusting them to the Divisions' needs. They may also suggest the fusion of similar themes.
- 15. Due to their dynamic nature, themes may be renewed or discontinued in the following year, depending on an assessment carried out by the Division's Scientific Committee and the ANPAD's Scientific Director.

Proposal format

- 16. The proposal must be submitted via the ANPAD's online system, available on www.anpad.org.br between August 13th,2024 and September 30th, 2024, and must inform:
 - a) Title of the proposed theme;
 - b) CPF/passport number of all members of the proposing team, in due order, including links to their CV Lattes;
 - c) Short biography (up to 200 words) of the proposing team members, describing their experience related to the proposed theme;
 - d) Description of the proposed theme justifying its relevance (from 150 to 300 words);
 - e) Keywords (3 to 5) and references for the theme (5 to 10).



Note: items "a, c, d, e" must be presented in Portuguese and English.

Final Disposition

17. The cases not covered in this call for theme proposals will be resolved by the ANPAD's Scientific Director, together with the Divisions coordinators.
